**SUBJECT:** USF Police to Conduct Comprehensive  
Roadside Safety Checkpoint

TAMPA: The University of South Florida Police Department will host a one-hour Comprehensive Roadside Safety Checkpoint on the USF Campus on October 18, 2014, beginning at 10:00 p.m. The checkpoint operation will be immediately followed by a 5-hour saturation patrol. During this time, USF Police Officers will seek to identify impaired drivers in an effort to keep our streets safe. Impaired drivers that are identified will face arrest and prosecution. This operation is part of a comprehensive, collaborative approach to traffic safety by the USF Police Department.
