- x 100% of respondents indicated that they can **assess a library community's information needs**.
- x 100% of respondents indicated that they can **build an appropriate library collection**.
- x 91.1% of respondents indicated that they can **apply management principles in a library work setting**.

Systems and Services

- x 93.3% of respondents indicated that they can **provide library service to diverse populations**.
- x 95.56% of respondents indicated that they can **use a variety of resources to provide library service**.

Knowledge Representation

- x 93.3% of respondents indicated that they can **organize information** based on the theories from library and information science.

Theory and Praxis

- x 97.1% of respondents indicated that they can **use quantitative methods** and 97.7% indicated that they can use **qualitative methods for problem solving**.
- x 95.6% of respondents indicated that they can **use quantitative** and 97.78% indicated that they can use **qualitative methods for research**.
- x 57.1% of respondents indicated that they have completed at least one research project while in the program.
