

FOR ABA PROGRAM Program Eligibility

In order to be eligible for the Project MABAS progra a student must:

- Have been accepted into the ABA Master's Program (online or campus program)
- Be a U.S. citizen or permanent U.S. resident
- Be a current Florida resident or willing to move to F
- Have goals consistent with the program (e.g., work interdisciplinary teams)
- A strong interest in working in the school system to enhance the promotion of mental health wellbeing of children and youth with or at risk for behavioral and mental health challenges

Application Process

All students accepted in the online or campus ABA M Programs are eligible to apply to participate in Project MABAS. The ABA Master's Program will distribute a MABAS application form to each student during the of classes.
