



FOR ABA PROGRAM Program Eligibility

In order to be eligible for the Project MABAS program a student must:

- Have been accepted into the ABA Master's Program (online or campus program)
- Be a U.S. citizen or permanent U.S. resident
- Be a current Florida resident or willing to move to Florida
- Have goals consistent with the program (e.g., work on interdisciplinary teams)
- A strong interest in working in the school system to enhance the promotion of mental health wellbeing of children and youth with or at risk for behavioral and mental health challenges

Application Process

All students accepted in the online or campus ABA Master's Programs are eligible to apply to participate in Project MABAS. The ABA Master's Program will distribute a MABAS application form to each student during the first semester of classes. Interested applicants should submit the completed application form, a letter of intent, and a curriculum vitae to Dr. Catia Cividini-Motta in the Department of Psychology (r-3nc080).



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
