According to the American Academy of Ophthalmology as many as three million Americans have glaucoma, but only half of them know it. The National Eye Institute of the National Institutes of Health (NIH) recently awarded Biomedical Engineering Professor Christopher Passaglia a four-year, \$1.4 million grant for his research on glaucoma.
