# MSEM Program Admission Requirements

### Admission Deadlines

Fall:February 15Spring:September 15Summer:January 15

#### Admission Minimum Requirements

- 1. A baccalaureate of science degree in Engineering from a regionally accredited institution. Other baccalaureate of science degrees in technical fields may be accepted on an individual basis.
- 2. A minimum grade point average of 3.0 out of a possible 4.0 for all undergraduate work taken during the last two years of the applicant's studies.
- 3. GRE is required with minimum scores of 156 for quantitative and 146 for verbal. GRE may be waved for Accelerated Program applicants.
- 4. English Language Proficiency<sup>1</sup>: International prospective students are required to have a minimum score on the TOEFL iBT score of 79.
- 5. A resume and a letter of recommendation.
- 6. At least 2 years of work experience in engineering or management. Otherwise, one or two semesters of internship may be required.

## Financial Aid

The department does <u>not</u> provide financial support (including graduate, teaching, or research assistantships) or tuition waivers to master's students.
