

## Student Accessibility Services

Realtime Translation (CART) service provider converts the spoken word into instant text (a familiar example=court reporter) This service is for D/HH persons not familiar with American Sign Language (ASL), that need to translate spoken words into printed English real-time format.

### General Guidance regarding communication with D/HH persons at USF

---

- x Individuals who are D/HH, may utilize different modes of communication and services to match that mode.
- x It is appropriate to ask an individual their preferred method of communication.
- x Brief interactions, such as giving directions to a campus building, establishing an appointment, or accessing a library book, can utilize communication tools such as writing, automatic captions on Microsoft Teams, texting, etc.
