The Student Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS) is based by the US Department of Homeland Security (DHS) to maintain information about certificated schools; under the US, and J-1 visiting scholars.

  - o F-1 students are required to report their physical US address lewithin 10 days This reported by updatingthe "local mailing" address in OASIS.   - o F-1 students are also required to maintain a foreign address while they are in the US studings. foreign address on the dmission application is imported to OASIS as the permanent foreign address. This address cannot be changed to a US address. It can be updated to another foreign address.
- x Spring Semester Enrollment
  - o F-1 and J students who do not follow enrollment rules for their visa status will be contacted by OIS via email. The email will include recommended action. Do not ignore the email.
  - o Students who have questions about their enrollment should attend in true in or Walk in hours to discuss with themmigration advisors DSOs
    - f F-1 and J1 undergraduate students must be enrolled in at least 12 credit hours.
    - f F-1 and J graduate students must be enrolled in at least 9 credit hours unless they have completed all coursework and are enrolled in only thesis or dissertation hours.
    - f All F1 and J1 students are restricted to counting one 3 credit hour online course towards the tirful enrollment.
    - f All F1 must enroll in the majority of their courses at their home campus as it appears on-20eir I
